All Northbound I-29/35 Traffic Shifts to Bond Bridge Today

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – All motorists headed northbound on Interstate 29/35 will drive on Kansas City’s newest Missouri River crossing – the Christopher S. Bond Bridge – starting today. The landmark structure features an array of 40 cables that radiate from a diamond-shaped center pylon, designed to provide a unique gateway experience for travelers.

“MoDOT and Paseo Corridor Constructors are working hard to keep our promise to open all lanes and ramps on this project by the end of the year,” said kcICON Project Director Brian Kidwell. “We are thankful to the traveling public for their patience and are pleased to be able to open additional lanes at this time. Motorists will continue to see more updates through this corridor in the coming weeks.”

Following striping work and traffic shifts this morning on northbound Interstate 29/35, two through lanes and one dedicated ramp lane will be open from Front Street to Bedford Avenue. There will be various lane closures north of Bedford Avenue to accommodate road-widening work.
