Southbound Interstate 29/35 Off-ramp to Paseo Boulevard Opens

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – The off-ramp from southbound Interstate 29/35 to Paseo Boulevard is scheduled to open Wednesday, September 29, 2010 following peak morning travel.

“The businesses, residents, and commuters in this area have been anticipating the reopening of this ramp for some time,” said Missouri Department of Transportation kcICON Project Director Brian Kidwell. “We appreciate their patience during construction.”

To save both time and money, three 150-foot concrete girders, the longest ever to be used in Missouri interstate bridge building, were used to construct the off-ramp. By implementing state-of-the-art best practices from around the country, MoDOT incorporated a Nebraska Department of Transportation innovative design to flyover all new northbound interstate lanes with a single span.
