Southbound I-29/35 Lanes Across the Bond Bridge Open Friday
Southbound I-29/35 off-ramp to Front Street to close the same day

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Southbound Interstate 29/35 across the new Bond Bridge will open two lanes to traffic on Friday, November 19, 2010. This shift will retire the Paseo Bridge to all traffic so that demolition work may begin. As part of this shift, the southbound Interstate 29/35 off-ramp to Front Street will be closed until the new ramp is in place by year’s end. The marked detour route will be southbound I-29/35 to eastbound Route 210/Armour Road to Route 269/Chouteau Avenue to westbound Front Street.

“This is a significant moment” said kcICON Project Director Brian Kidwell. “The Paseo Bridge has served us well for 56 years, but today’s regional traffic volumes demand significant changes. MoDOT and Paseo Corridor Constructors are pleased to deliver 4.7 miles of interstate improvements and a new landmark bridge for the greater Kansas City community on budget and over six months ahead of schedule.”
